After the establishment of the Pacific Flying Labs in Fiji we are looking to build additional capacity in the region. To do this, we are inviting young professionals from the region to become certified drone pilots and support the work of Pacific Flying Labs. As such, we are looking for highly motivated young professionals from Fiji and Vanuatu who wish to pursue a career in the use of drones for positive social impact. Thanks to generous support from DFAT, WeRobotics will cover all certification costs and travel costs for selected participants. The certification training requires 6-full days and said training will take place in Fiji. The training is expected to take place in early November 2018. Important: the training takes 6 days so applicants must be able to commit to the full 6 days including travel to/from the training venue.

Ideal candidates will already have an interest in the use of drones and may already have some experience in flying drones. That said, prior experience is not a must. More important is passion and a hard-work ethic as well as a genuine commitment to improve livelihoods in the South Pacific. We highly encourage women and minority groups to apply for this trainings. In return for having all the training and travel costs covered by WeRobotics, certified pilots will be expected to become an active member of Pacific Flying Labs and to collaborate on at least 3 key projects with the 12 months following the certification training.
