### Job description

The Online Educator will also customize the selected online training platform and work with WeRobotics to co-develop high quality content and/or improve existing content that will drive a series of online trainings on the use of drones in the social sector. In addition, she/he will work with the communications lead at WeRobotics to ensure that the WeRobotics brand strategy is embedded into the online trainings. Finally, the Online Educator will also craft the strategy for outreach and recruitment of participants for WeRobotics online trainings.
