

## **WeRobotics - Communications Intern for Flying Labs**

WeRobotics is a nonprofit organisation dedicated to shifting the power back to local experts. Local expertise is indispensable to the sustainable and meaningful impact of “Technology for Good” projects. WeRobotics, therefore, works directly with local experts in Africa, Asia, Latin America, and beyond who seek to expand their skills along with access to emerging technologies and new leadership opportunities to accelerate and scale the positive social change. WeRobotics does this by co-creating a growing network of Flying Labs in Asia, Africa, Latin America, and Oceania. These labs are led entirely by local experts who use emerging technologies to increase the impact of humanitarian, environmental, and public health projects. This new internship opportunity will directly support Flying Labs in their communications and storytelling efforts, which is key to systems change. The intern will work directly with Flying Labs in some 30 countries around the world to provide them with dedicated communication support and skills necessary to tell their own stories in compelling and innovative ways. WeRobotics is a globally distributed team, so this position is remote, though talent from and/or based in Africa, Asia, or Latin America preferred. This is a paid internship.

**Location:** Remote; dependable Internet connectivity required.

**Type of Contract: Full or Part-time (deliverables based), 3-6 months**

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### **General responsibilities**

- Support and train Flying Labs on compelling storytelling particularly through the use of multimedia. Enable Flying Labs to create short (30-60 seconds) video pieces that are original, edgy, and insightful.
- Support and train Flying Labs on how and when to write effective updates on social media based on different channels and audiences.
- Identify appropriate social media for Flying Labs where they should be most active to raise their profiles

## Requirements

- A bachelor's or master's degree in communications, video production, etc
- Proven experience and track record in storytelling, including using multimedia
- Experience in creating multimedia content, especially videos
- A social media presence, especially Twitter
- Excellent command of English; French or Spanish fluency
- Curious, open-minded
- Responsible, highly reliable, and self-motivated
- Experience with drones (hobby or professional) is a plus
